### **Background Information**

Nutrix Co. (i.e. "New Tricks") was originally established as Nutrix Novelty Library, as the mail order component of Irving Klaw and his sister's New York used bookshop; Nutrix sold magic tricks and novelties. After seeing a little girl rip a picture of Clark Gable from a photo magazine at their bookshop, the Klaws expanded into selling still photographs of movie stars, later further growing to include pinups of movie stars and erotic photographs, some of which they offered through a biannual mail-order catalog know as Cartoon and Model Parade. As success came, the store moved, hours increased, and the business was renamed as "Irving Klaw's Pin-Up Photos" and then soon changed again to "Movie Star News." This prompted Klaw to stop selling books and focus on erotic photography. Klaw, the self proclaimed 'pin up king', not only sold movie stills and celebrity pin-ups but was taking his own pin-up photos as well, with models such as Bettie Page. By the late 1940s, Klaw was shooting many 'damsel in distress' type images, popularized by movies of the era, as well as fetish and bondage images. In 1955, Klaw had to appear in the Senate, The company was limited to mail order due to legal difficulties, Nutrix Co. was eventually sold to Edward Mishkin, who changed the name to Mutrix Co. Mishkin was also arrested for publishing materials related to sadism and masochism in the 1950s, and again for porn in the 1960s, with his appeal denied in the Supreme Court in 1966. This collection includes zines published by both Mutrix and Nutrix, with all of the zines having an emphasis on bondage and gender. Some are erotic stories with illustrations while others are more typical magazines, with readers submitting their own pictures.
